House of Delegates Minutes

February 27, 2016

The House of Delegates was called to order at 11:34 am by Governor Jessica Cook.

Elections Chair, Brittany Munyer, reported the following:

There were 34 voting delegates in the house representing 10 clubs in good standing in the Florida District. 18 votes were needed for a simple majority and 23 votes were needed for a two thirds majority.

Election of District Officers

Elections Chair reported that Amanda Gorgy, FSU, was elected as the 2016-2017 Florida District Panhandle Lieutenant Governor.

The floor was opened for further nominations for the office of Sunbelt Lieutenant Governor, there were no further nominations.

The floor was opened for further nominations for the office of Suncoast Lieutenant Governor, there were no further nominations.

The floor was opened for further nominations for the office of Suwannee Lieutenant Governor, there were no further nominations. Diamond Pichardo, UF, waived her speech.

The Suwannee Division voted by acclamation.

Elections Chair reported that Diamond Pichardo, UF, was elected as the 2016-2017 Florida District Suwannee Lieutenant Governor.

Endorsements for International Office

The floor was opened for further nominations for International Endorsement. Robert Brown, USF, nominated Katie Pope, UCF, for endorsement for International Trustee. Tiffany Campbell, UCF, seconded.

Katie Pope spoke for 2 minutes regarding her decision to seek endorsement for International Trustee.

The house casted a vote by ballot for this endorsement. Katie Pope, UCF, was unanimously endorsed for International Trustee.
